SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN

THIS AGREEMENT made this	day of	, 2024, by and between the Scotch
Plains Fanwood Board of Education (h	ereinafter ref	erred to as "Board"), and the
Township of Scotch Plains (hereinafter	r referred to a	s the "Township");

WHEREAS, Board and Township are interested in entering into an Interlocal Services Agreement for the purpose of sharing the services of a Class II or Class III Special Officer ("Officer"); and

WHEREAS, the Board and Township have agreed that the Board will pay for the Special Officers on a part time basis, at an hourly rate; (not to exceed the limit on hours worked weekly where the officer would qualify for healthcare by law);

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties as follow:

1. Services

The Township, through its police department, shall assign a Class II or III Special Law Enforcement Officer (SLEO) who will serve as security for the Scotch Plains Fanwood Public Schools. If Class II SLEO are hired, instead of Class III SLEO, they will also receive School Resource Officer (SRO) training, the same that is required of Class III SLEO, and the SLEO II's hired for school security will preferably be retired law enforcement officers for the State of New Jersey or New Jersey State Police. At all times during the assignment the Officer shall be a Township employee, will work under the rules and regulations of the Township's police department, the Township of Scotch Plains, and the policies and regulations of the Board when present on school grounds.

The Officer shall report directly to the Township Chief of Police and while on school grounds shall work in cooperation with the building administration and the Superintendent of Schools.

2. Schedule of Services

The Officer shall provide services to the Board for approximately 25 to 35 hours per week on average for the year, while school is in session under a schedule to be mutually determined by the Township's Police Chief and the Board's Superintendent of Schools.

3. Cost of Services

The Board of Education agrees to be responsible for all salary costs for the Officer. The Township agrees to be responsible for all other costs including but not limited to training, uniforms, weapons, vehicles, etc.

4. Duration

This Agreement shall cover the school year 2024-2025 and 2025-2026. Any future Agreements shall be renewed bi-annually, and appointments of SLEO's shall done annually in accordance with NJ Law.

Any renewal of the Agreement shall be in writing and approved by each party by formal resolution before becoming effective.

5. Indemnification and Insurance

Each party assumes all liability for, and agrees to indemnify and hold the other party and its agents, servants, employees, students, guests, licensees and invitees, harmless from and against any and all claims, losses, damages, injuries and expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees, arising out of, resulting from, or incurred in connection with, any acts or omissions by the party, its agents, servants or employees related to the perf01mance of its obligations under the te1ms of this Agreement.

Both parties shall maintain full and complete liability insurance, in limits not less than the maximum amounts of liability coverage now maintained by each party, throughout the term of this

Agreement and cause the other party to be designated on its policy as an additional insured.

6. Modification

This Agreement may only be modified by an instrument in writing signed by both parties to the Agreement.

7. Severability

If any of the provisions contained in this Agreement are held illegal, invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

8. Termination

This agreement may be telminated by either party giving the other party thirty (30) days written notice.

9. Governing Law

This Agreement shall be governed, construed and interpreted in accordance with the law of the State of New Jersey. Specifically, this agreement is entered into pursuant to N.JS.A.40A:65-1 et seq.

10. Assignment

Neither party may transfer or assign any of its rights or obligations under this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other, and any such transfer or assignment or attempt thereat shall be null and void.

11. Counterparts

This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, which, taken together, shall constitute but one instrument. It is not necessary that all parties sign all or any one of the counterparts, but each party must sign at least one counterpart for the Agreement to be effective.
