# Mountainside Recreation Stepped Up To Help Our Students Have Access to their Tennis Courts without Forcing the District to Sign a Lease Agreement

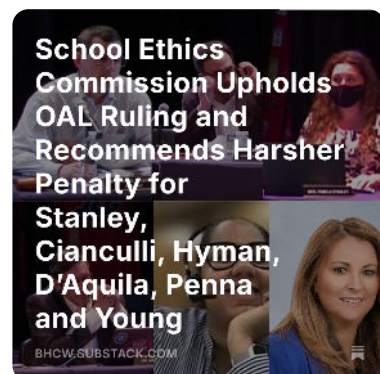
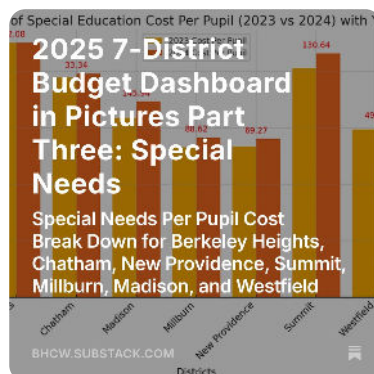
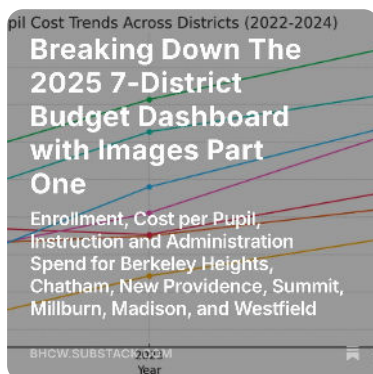
While Mayor Devanney and Our Rec Department Spent their Time Playing Politics with Our Students and Writing Innacurate Articles
