# Mountainside Recreation Stepped Up To Help Our Students Have Access to their Tennis Courts without Forcing the District to Sign a Lease Agreement




The Township-approved Lease Agreement makes no mention of the tennis courts on township property. It solely pertains to the BOE property being leased, which includes just one tennis court.
