



The timing—right in the middle of the workday makes it difficult for most families to attend. We can only assume that's intentional, to limit who shows up and what gets said. Unlike the BOE, the Council does not allow Zoom Participants to speak.


This week, we'll be transitioning to a new hosting provider due to disk space getting tight and traffic demands continuing to increase.
