

The Township of Berkeley Heights is issuing a crucial advisory to all residents about fatbergs. A fatberg is a massive, rock-like mass of waste matter in a sewer system formed by the combination of flushed non-biodegradable solids (such as wet wipes) with fat, oil, and grease (FOG) deposits that have cooled and congealed to create sludge blockages in the system. Scraps and leftovers from dishes and cooking that are washed down the drain, add to the buildup.

As the blockage forms, sewage can overflow resulting in property damage and the spread of harmful toxins into local water sources. Please be mindful and help us keep our systems clear.


