Thank you for sharing your insights on NJ DOE adaptive testing. This roll out reminds me the common core phase out by NJ DOE. New Jersey officially phased out the Common Core State Standards in 2016. After a year-long review ordered by then-Governor Chris Christie, the state revised the standards and renamed all nine content areas the New Jersey Student Learning Standards (NJSLS). The new standards took effect in the 2017-2018 school year.


