Hi John,

Thank you for the question.

The referendum includes upgrades to the District's camera systems, primarily to add additional cameras in order to improve coverage and reduce blind spots or areas that are not currently adequately monitored.

The system has not yet been designed. The scope and budget are based on current technology and vendor pricing, developed in consultation with the District's Technology Department. There is no current plan to include AI or facial recognition software as part of this project.

Because most modern camera systems operate through secure web-based portals, it is technically feasible for the Police Department to be granted access provided the District adopts or maintains a policy permitting that access. (This would be coordinated with the District administration, Board and the Technology Department.)

In addition to cameras, Question #1 also includes upgrades to:

- Master Clock systems
- Communications systems
- Public Address (PA) systems

The total cost of the security and technology projects included in Question #1 is approximately \$1.6 million.
