**SYNOPSIS**

Provides that average time to issue licenses to physicians shall not exceed 51 days.

1 AN ACT concerning physician licensing and supplementing chapter  
2 9 of Title 45 of the Revised Statutes.

4 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
5 *of New Jersey:*

7 1. a. The State Board of Medical Examiners shall ensure that  
8 the average time to grant or deny an application for a license to  
9 practice medicine and surgery shall not exceed 51 days from the  
10 date the board has received all information necessary to process an  
11 application for licensure.

12 b. The board shall annually submit a report to the Legislature,  
13 pursuant to section 2 of P.L.1991, c.164 (C.52:14-19.1), which  
14 provides information on the progress of the board towards the  
15 performance measure target provided in subsection a. of this  
16 section.

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18 2. This act shall take effect on the 90th day next following  
19 enactment.

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STATEMENT

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24 This bill requires the State Board of Medical Examiners to  
25 ensure that the average time to grant or deny applications for a  
26 license to practice medicine and surgery does not exceed 51 days  
27 from the date the board has received all information necessary to  
28 process an application for licensure.

29 The bill also requires the board to annually submit a report to the  
30 Legislature which provides information on the progress of the board  
31 towards the performance measure target provided in the bill.
