SYNOPSIS

Directs professional and occupational boards to promulgate rules for licensee use of generative artificial intelligence.

CURRENT VERSION OF TEXT

As introduced.



1 AN ACT concerning generative artificial intelligence use in
2 regulated professions and occupations and supplementing Title
3 45 of the Revised Statutes.

5 **BE IT ENACTED** *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
6 *of New Jersey:*

8 1. a. Within three months after the date of enactment of
9 this act, and notwithstanding the provisions of the "Administrative
10 Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.) to the
11 contrary, the Director of the Division of Consumer Affairs shall,
12 immediately upon filing proper notice with the Office of
13 Administrative Law, adopt rules and regulations establishing a
14 model policy for the use of generative artificial intelligence by a
15 licensee in the practice of a profession or occupation regulated by
16 each professional or occupation board designated in section 2 of
17 P.L.1978, c.73 (C.45:1-15).

18 b. Within six months or at the next regularly scheduled meeting
19 of a professional or occupational board following the establishment
20 by the director of the model policy required pursuant to subsection
21 a. of this section, each professional or occupational board shall,
22 notwithstanding the provisions of the "Administrative Procedure
23 Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et seq.) to the contrary,
24 promulgate rules and regulations adopting the model policy with
25 any profession or occupation-specific adaptations deemed necessary
26 by the professional or occupational board.

27 c. The rules and regulations adopted pursuant to subsections a.
28 and b. of this section shall be in effect for a period not to exceed
29 one year after the date of the filing. These rules and regulations
30 shall thereafter be adopted, amended, or readopted by the Director
31 of the Division of Consumer Affairs and each professional and
32 occupational board in accordance with the requirements of the
33 "Administrative Procedure Act," P.L.1968, c.410 (C.52:14B-1 et
34 seq.).

35 d. As used in this section, "generative artificial intelligence"
36 means a technology system that: (1) is trained on data; (2) is
37 designed to simulate human communication through one or more of
38 the following: (a) text; (b) audio; or (c) visual communication; and
39 (3) generates non-scripted outputs with limited or no human
40 oversight.

42 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

45 STATEMENT

47 This bill requires the Director of the Division of Consumer
48 Affairs to adopt emergency rules regulations establishing a model

1 policy for the use of generative artificial intelligence by a licensee
2 in the practice of a profession or occupation regulated by each
3 professional and occupation board within the division. The model
4 policy is to be established within three months of the bill's
5 enactment. Within six months of the establishment of the model
6 policy or at the next regularly scheduled meeting of each
7 professional or occupational board, each professional and
8 occupation board is to adopt the model policy with any necessary
9 profession or occupation-specific adaptations.

10 As used in the bill, "generative artificial intelligence" means a
11 technology system that: (1) is trained on data; (2) is designed to
12 simulate human communication through one or more of the
13 following: (a) text; (b) audio; or (c) visual communication; and (3)
14 generates non-scripted outputs with limited or no human oversight.
